# HISTORY



The Kumho Tyre Super3 Series was originally created in 2008 as part of the Shannons Australian Motor Racing Nationals and was then known as the Kumho Tyre V8 Touring Car Series.

It was created to provide a category of racing for Supercars no longer used in the main Supercars Championship or Super2 Series.



It held its first round at Mallala that year with just four cars but has grown rapidly over the following years to the point where it has, as of 2019, become the official third tier of Supercars competition.

The cars race with a control Kumho tyre, 7500 rev limit and have quickly built a following - particularly with plenty of teams presenting their cars in 'retro' liveries.
